

Hygiene concept

Guidelines of the BG Allgäu-Bodensee:

- The health and maintenance of health is the top priority
- We appeal to our members, participants and guests to take responsibility
- The cleanliness in our premises is important to us
- We all adhere to the specifications of this concept.

Zoning

- ❖ Zone 1: restaurant
- ❖ Zone 1.1: Food distribution - terrace
- ❖ Zone 2: spectator area - designated area
- ❖ Zone 3: Event area - ring with outer border
- ❖ Zone 4: Parking lot and preparation area, this includes all access roads
- ❖ Zone 5: Toilets - can be used by everyone. Please only enter individually

Regulations for the zones

- ❖ Zone 1: Access exclusively for the assigned helpers to fulfill their assigned tasks
- ❖ Zone 1.1: The terrace is closed to people. Here takes place exclusively the preparation of meals and their serving.

A One-way regulation is introduced

- ❖ Zone 2: stay for spectators and guests. The toilets are shared by everyone to use. The viewing area at the dog park is largely cordoned off
put on the ring.
- ❖ Zone 3: No access for guests or spectators
- ❖ Zone 4: Can be used by everyone. No inpatient stay for guests or spectators
- ❖ Zone 5: regular cleaning, for sufficient hand washing soap (liquid soap) and

Disposable paper towels are provided. Only one person is allowed in the toilet hold up

General requirements

❖ People with typical Corona symptoms are not allowed to attend the event participate or be present. Here we appeal to the personal responsibility

Participants, spectators and guests

❖ Participation or stay on the event site is people

Prohibited from a risk area defined by the federal government

arriving, or stayed there in the last 10 days. By proof

of a negative Covid19 test, which must not be older than 72 hours, is the

Participation possible for these people.

❖ Access to zone 3 is limited to 2 people per dog

❖ A minimum distance of 1.5 meters from other people must always be maintained. Is if this is not possible, mouth-nose protection is worn

❖ Only so many participant reports are accepted that the hygiene rules can be adhered to.

❖ The maximum number of participants is limited to 40 dogs.

❖ There are no more than 80 people at any time in Zones 2 and 3 hold up

Hygiene rules

❖ there are sufficient disinfectant dispensers distributed across all zones Use set up

❖ Welcome rituals such as shaking hands or similar. is to be renounced. "We are not rude but worry about the health of all of us "

❖ in the toilets regularly for cleanliness and sufficient hand washing soap, as well as disposable paper towels provided

❖ in zones 1 and 1.1 all persons wear mouth and nose protection when they

Give out drinks or food. This obligation can be omitted if an over

Separating disk set up at face height between the issuer and recipient
is set up.

❖ Drinks are served as closed as possible. When bottle opener for

Are provided, they must be disinfected after each use

❖ the preparation of the food takes place with the mouth and nose protection on

Registration.

Participants can register outdoors.

Event

The event takes place exclusively outdoors.

Data collection

All persons present on the event site are identified by name, with a

Accessibility as well as the length of stay (from - to) recorded.

The data are stored in accordance with the respective requirements of the state government BW

and
